We ask that you read the following CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT. **THE SIGNED SHEET IS TO BE BROUGHT TO CAMP AND HANDED IN AT REGISTRATION.** This will ensure that, should the Camp Director find it necessary to send a camper home, everyone concerned will be aware of the particular part of the CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT that has been broken.

Sherbrooke Lake Camp Council would like to reassure you that sending a camper home would be a final measure- after all other means of dealing with the situation have failed.

### **CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Male and female cabins are out of bounds for the opposite gender.
2. Smoking is prohibited. All cigarettes will be confiscated and the camper will be sent home.
3. Drugs or alcohol are NOT permitted at camp. It will be confiscated and the campers will be sent home immediately.
4. All medications and over the counter drugs are to be given to the First Aider on registration day.
5. No inappropriate language, actions and/or profanity by the camper.
6. Graffiti and/or damage to any part of the camp is prohibited. Parents/guardians will be required to pay for any intentional damages caused by their son/daughter.
7. Failure to follow curfew, as set out by the Camp Director may result in a request for parents to pick up the campers immediately.
8. Campers are not to be at the waterfront at any time other than those authorized by the Camp Director
9. Campers must keep their belongings and cabins clean and tidy, both for hygiene and safety reasons.
10. Campers must participate in ALL activities and duties unless excused by the Camp Director.
11. Campers are responsible for their belongings and are to treat other campers and their belongings with respect.
12. Electronic devices such as iPods, laptop/netbook computers, mP3 players, cell phones or others deemed by the Camp Director are permitted at camp. Any brought to camp will be confiscated and returned on the last day of camp.
13. Overall camper supervision is under the supervision of the Camp Director.
