Pick up: Friday- 12:30pm
Medications: Bring all medications to registration clearly marked with instructions and labels for the First Aider.

There are still spaces in most camps, if you wish to attend a second camp or if you know someone else who would like to attend, please contact us soon.

The following is a list of items that you should bring to camp:

- sleeping bag, mattress
- pillow, extra blanket
- pajamas
- sweatshirts, t-shirts, jackets (regular and rain)
- pants, shorts
- socks and underwear
- boots, sneakers, sandals
- nice outfit for turkey dinner
- bathing suit (two-piece prohibited)
- flashlight
- beach towels
- toiletries
- bug repellent (no aerosol)
- sunscreen
- water bottle & hat
- camera
- Bible (optional)
- laundry bag

A few things to remember:

- There isn't any need to have extra money during camp. Everything is included in the cost of camp as T-shirts and sweatshirts are pre-ordered.
- If you have registered as a TADPOLE (6 or 7 years old), please remember that you will only be at camp for 3 nights. However, if you decide you'd like to stay for the full 5 nights once you arrive, this can be discussed on registration day.
- If you wish to send mail to a camper please address it as stated on our brochure and include the camp they are attending. Ensure you mail it the week before the camper will be there or leave it with David Simpson, the Camp Director on registration day.

Cancellation Policy: As stated in our camp brochure, \$50 is non-refundable (unless your preferred camp was full). Any cancellations after June 1st are nonrefundable, except with a doctor's certificate. If you have a change after this date and there is room we will try to accommodate your child in another camp. Refunds will not be issues in instances where a camper is removed from the camp program at the choice or request of: the Camp Director, the camper (ie. Homesickness) and/or the camper's parents/guardians.
