



SHERBROOKE LAKE CAMP CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

The goal of our camp is to ensure it is the best place for kids to learn, to play, to be cared for, to be themselves and to live in the community in the safest place possible. Our Camper Code of Conduct outlines the rules and behaviour expectations for campers that must be followed while at Sherbrooke Lake Camp.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) and Campers are asked to read this Camper Code of Conduct together and must sign indicating their understanding and agreement.

Staff will reinforce the code of conduct with Campers to help ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience at Sherbrooke Lake Camp. **Serious or repeated violations of this Camper Code of Conduct may require a camper to be picked up and sent home with their parent/guardian.** Sending a camper home will be the last resort, depending on the severity of the situation. **Parents or designates must be available to do so if required.**

- Campers will follow all of the Sherbrooke Lake Camp policies and procedures as communicated by staff.
- 2022 Summer guidelines regarding COVID-19 will be reviewed and must be followed by all campers.
- Campers must treat other campers, staff, and volunteers with respect. Bullying, harrassment, discrimination, and abusive language or behaviour will not be tolerated. No profanity.
- We encourage campers to form positive friendships but camp is not the place for physical romantic displays of affection.
- Camp property, buildings and equipment must be treated with respect. No graffiti, etc. Parent(s)/guardian(s) will be required to pay for any damages caused by their child.
 - *Campers may not write on or sign the walls or bunks within the cabins.
- Campers are responsible for their own belongings and are to treat the belongings of others with respect.
- Campers are not to be at the waterfront at any time without waterfront staff.
- Campers are to wear closed shoes when asked and must always have footwear on, except on the beach.
- Campers must participate in activities and duties unless an arrangement is made with the Camp Director.
- Once campers are assigned to their cabins, entering the other cabins will be prohibited.
- Campers are to remain in their cabins at night. Curfew violations will be taken seriously.
- Cell phones and electronics (with the exception of cameras) are not permitted outside of cabins. If used inappropriately they will be confiscated and returned on the last day. Serious violations may require a camper to be sent home.
- Campers are to respect the privacy of others at all times. Pictures of a sensitive nature are not to be taken of people and are definitely not to be shared by email, text or on social media sites.
- Campers are not to handle medication. All medications should be labeled with all instructions, the camp healthcare provider will administer the medications as instructed by parents/guardians.
- Sherbrooke Lake is a tobacco, recreational alcohol and drug-free facility. Possession or use of these substances is strictly prohibited. Using a Vape or the vaping of any substance is also prohibited. These items will be confiscated and the camper will be sent home.
